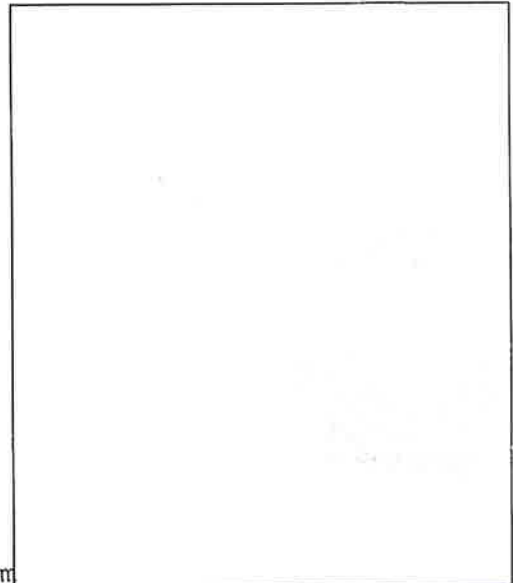

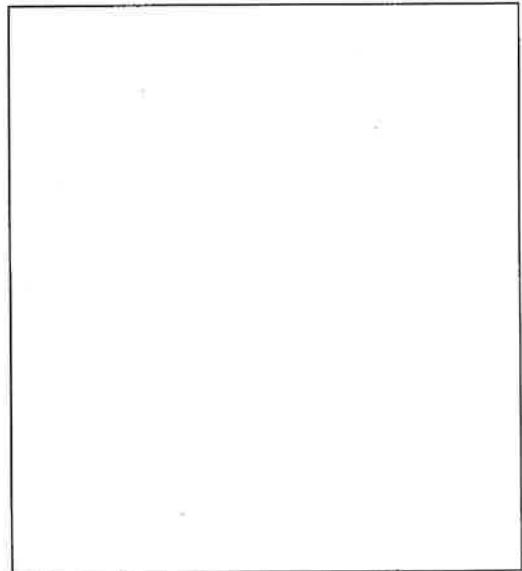

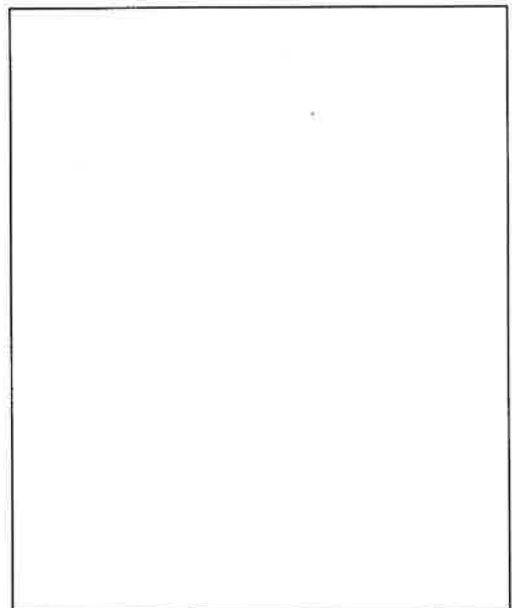

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, that if Principal is awarded the Contract upon such Bid and thereafter within the period of time specified in Agency's bidding documents governing the bidding process applicable to such Bid ("Bidding Documents") enters into the Contract with Agency on the terms and conditions required by the Bidding Documents and furnishes the performance and payment bonds, evidence of insurance and other documents that Principal is required to submit under the terms of the Bidding Documents, then this obligation shall be null and void; otherwise, it shall remain in full force and effect and the sum guaranteed by this bond shall, at the option of Agency, be forfeited to Agency to pay all losses and damages suffered by Agency as a result thereof and permitted by applicable law, including, without limitation, the difference between the Bid Amount and amount for which the Agency may legally contract with another party to perform the Work (if such latter amount be greater than the Bid Amount), costs of publication, and all other losses and damages suffered by Agency (including, without limitation, those associated with delay to the Project); provided, however, that Surety's liability shall not exceed the penal amount of this bond.


