Transportation

RAIL: Main line of Burlington Northern Santa Fe. There is Metrolink commuter rail service to Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego Counties.

TRUCK: 54 carriers in Corona.

OVERNIGHT DELIVERY TO: Los Angeles, San Francisco, San Diego and Phoenix.

AIR: LA/Ontario International Airport (owned and operated by Los Angeles World Airports), 15 mi. north, is served by AeroMexico, Alaska Airlines, American Airlines, Continental, Delta Airlines, Great Lakes Airlines, Southwest Airlines, United Airlines, United Express and US Airways. Riverside Municipal Airport, 10 mi. northeast, has general aviation facilities, 5,400 ft. runway. Corona Municipal Airport has a 3,200 ft. runway and general aviation facilities.

BUS: City-operated Dial-A-Ride system; RTA service to Riverside; OCTA service to Orange County.

PORTS: Nearest ports are in Los Angeles-Long Beach, 50 mi. west, and San Diego, 96 mi. south.

HIGHWAYS: Calif. 91 northeast to Riverside and San Bernardino, southwest to Orange County and Long Beach, I-15 north to Ontario and Las Vegas, south to San Diego. There are connections via I-15 and the Calif. 91 to Calif. 60 east-west and to I-10 east-west. The Orange County Transportation Authority freeway toll lanes are at the Orange County line and the Eastern Transportation Corridor toll road is open.

Industrial Sites

Public Services

Typical sale prices for raw land are \$10.00 to \$15.00 per square foot. There are 3,272 acres in the city limits zoned for light to heavy industry. Corona's industrial base has played an important role in the growth of the City and its employee base. Corona has more than 32 million square feet of existing industrial space with a vacancy rate of 7.5% at the end of 2009.

- Fire Department: The Corona Fire Department is located at City Hall. Corona has 7 fire stations distributed throughout the city, staffed by 128 personnel on 7 paramedic engines and 2 ladder/truck companies. We cross staff 2 brush engines, 1 Hazardous Materials unit, and 1 water tender. Each year the Fire Department responds to approximately 10,000 calls for service.
- Fire Insurance Classification: Source of Rating: Insurance Services Office. City rating: 2. Adjacent unincorporated area: 6 to 9.
- Major Capital Improvement Projects anticipated to be commenced or completed by the City include: Magnolia/Interstate 15 interchange expansion reconstruct ramps, widen the southbound entry and northbound exit ramps from 1 to 2 lanes and install a new ramp meter and traffic signals; Modify the interchange at Serfas Club Drive and the 91 Freeway; Road improvements to Foothill Parkway from I-15/El Cerrito to California Avenue; Widen Cajalco Road from 2 to 4 lanes from Temescal Canyon Road to Bedford Canyon Road and widen ramps from 1 to 2 lanes.

Characteristics of the Labor Force

Corona employment and payroll data confirm that the City is emerging as the next chapter in the "Orange County story" as people and companies migrate to Corona to avoid the lack of space, higher costs and infrastructure difficulties in that county. Recent census information found that, by occupation, the largest portion of Corona's residents (33%) were managers, professionals and technicians.

Community Facilities

HEALTH: Corona has 1 regional hospital, with 240 beds, 266 physicians/surgeons, 163 dentists, 27 optometrists, 4 podiatrists and 53 chiropractors.

EDUCATION: The Corona-Norco Unified School District has 31 elementary schools, 8 intermediate schools, 5 high schools, 3 continuation high schools, 1 middle college high school, 2 alternative schools and 1 special education school. Thirteen private schools are located in Corona.

Institutions of higher education accessible to Corona residents include the University of California, Riverside, Cal Poly State University, Pomona, Cal State University, San Bernardino, California Baptist University, La Sierra University and Norco College.

CULTURAL: 91 churches, 1 synagogue, 3 libraries, 2 newspapers, 2 radio stations, 7 TV channels received direct, 1 TV cable system, 36 banks, 1 savings and loan, 36 community and neighborhood parks and playgrounds and 3 movie theaters with 48 screens. Corona is in close proximity to Orange County beaches and tourist attractions, metropolitan Los Angeles cultural and recreational facilities, inland mountains and desert resorts and Lake Perris and Lake Elsinore state parks.

Housing Availability, Prices & Rentals

According to the California Department of Finance, there are 45,803 housing units in Corona. The housing stock consists of 31,768 single detached units, 2,359 single attached units, 2,229 multiple 2 to 4 units, 7,834 multiple 5 plus units and 1,613 mobile homes.

The median sales price for new and existing homes in Corona is \$327,250, as reported by DataQuick for September 2010.

There are 17 hotels/motels, with 979 rooms, in Corona.

There are 16 mobile home and RV parks in Corona with 1,533 mobile home spaces and 635 RV spaces.

Remarks

The City of Corona continues to be a growing and influential business center in Southern California. With close to 2 million square feet of commercial space, Corona remains an attractive and dynamic community for business. The City is firing on all cylinders, expanding its job base, increasing sales tax revenue and planning a prosperous future for all who live, work and play here.
